Love God

Position	Time Commitment	Description
Host	1 hour weekly	Oversee the recruitment, training and scheduling of Greeters for weekend worship services. Serve as a connector for guests by helping them feel at home and understand the layout of the facility as well as connecting guests to the Pastor and staff.
Greeters	.5 hours weekly	Warmly welcome people as they enter the building. Provide information about our facility for guests, such as the location of restrooms, coffee bar, nursery, and Sunday School classes. Introduce guests to the Pastor and staff. Encourage guests to provide contact information for follow up connections.
Coffee Bar	.5-1 hour weekly	Prepare coffee. Be sure to give guests a special cup of coffee. Ideally we need three teams: one to brew and set up, one to keep the coffee percolating and one to clean up.
Ushers	1.5 hours weekly	Help seat people, hand out programs, handle crowd control, take the offering, guide people up for the Lord's Supper, and provide information about our facility to those who need assistance.
Communion Servers	1 hour weekly	Assist the Pastor in serving the Lord's Supper at Worship Services.
Communion Set-up/ Clean-up	1-2 hours weekly	Serve on a rotating team that prepares the bread and wine for the Lord's Supper and cleans up afterward.
Sermon Team	1 hour weekly	Help with gathering illustrations, research content, theme/series planning, and stage design.
Prayer Team after Worship Services	.5 hours weekly	Be up front and available to pray with people after worship as they need it.

Position	Time Commitment	Description
Worship Team Musician	6-8 hours weekly	He or she has a positive attitude and a desire to contribute to the wellness of the team and the goals and expectations of the worship leader and pastor; as well as the ability to perform consistently on tempo and on the correct note. Has experience and is proficient in this field.
Worship Team Vocalist	6-8 hours weekly	He or she has a positive attitude and a desire to contribute to the wellness of the team and the goals and expectations of the worship leader and pastor; as well as the ability to perform consistently on tempo and on the correct note. Has experience and is proficient in this field.
Worship Tech Team Audio	6-8 hours weekly	Ability to understand and operate the sound department, as well as the ability to trouble shoot the system. Maintain the direction of the mix and sound level as set forth by the worship leader. Has experience and is proficient in this field.
Worship Tech Team Lighting	6-8 hours weekly	Ability to understand and operate the lighting system and build new lighting cues as needed. Ability to understand proper timing and transitions needed to create wanted atmosphere. Has experience and is proficient in this field.
Worship Tech Team Media	6-8 hours weekly	Ability to understand and operate the media tools as well as the ability to trouble shoot the system when needed. The ability to understand proper transitions and timing to create wanted atmosphere. Has experience and is proficient in this field.
Sermon PowerPoint Team	1 hour monthly	Serve on a rotating team. Create PowerPoint for Pastor's sermon. Be aware of what other churches are doing in this area. Resource teammates with new slide ideas that you find and new websites that provides slides for church use. Resource image websites.

Position	Time Commitment	Description
Contribution Teller	5 hours 2 x per month	This individual inputs and posts individual offerings into the church's database.
Baptism Banners	2-4 hours as needed	Create the Baptism banner for those being baptized.
Kitchen Care	.1-2 hours monthly	Many groups throughout the week use our kitchen. Help organize and keep this space available for others to use.
Re-Stock Kitchen	2 hours monthly	Take inventory of paper products on a monthly basis, pick up supplies, and re-stock as needed.
Pick-up Janitorial Supplies	1-2 hours Bi-monthly	Pick up "pulled" supplies from Sam's and re-stock our closet.
Facility Care	As needed	This is the "behind the scenes crew". Painting, cleaning, repairing, and building projects are just some of the things to be done around the church. Flexible hours are available to fit your schedule.
Landscape Care	Time given is determined by the individual	Curb appeal is our first impression to a visitor or someone driving by. Make Lord of Life shine with God's plants through helping with yard work and landscaping.

Position	Time Commitment	Description
Adult Small Group Leader	6–15 hours monthly	Invite others to join you weekly or bi-weekly to grow in your relationships with one another as well as in your relationships with Christ. The small group leader serves as the shepherd of those in their small group.
Adult Small Group Ministry Team	5-8 hours monthly	Help with the strategy and organization of our small group ministry. Serve as coaches to other small group leaders.
Adult Sunday School Class Leaders	2-4 hours/week 6-8 week sessions	Plan, prepare, and teach Bible courses and Bible based curriculum. Connect with others as a mentor to strengthen and multiply teachers.
Adventure Outpost Leader	1-2 hours monthly	Oversee small group of children monthly. Build relationships with children in your small group. Participate in songs, games and large group lesson. Participate in leadership team training.
Nursery Care	1-1.5 hours weekly	Create a safe place and care for children 0-3 years of age
Cradle Roll	2-4 hours monthly	Coordinate regular sending of "Growing in Christ Nursery Roll" packets to families of newborns.
College Ministry	2-3 hours monthly	Organize the entirety of sending 4-5 care packages to our college students throughout the school year. Recruit parents to participate in this ministry to college students.
Stephen Ministry	1-2 hours weekly when assigned	Assist the Pastor in providing Christian one-on-one care to those in our congregation and community who are experiencing all kinds of life needs and circumstances. 50 hours of training is required.
Children and Jr. High Sunday School Leader	2-3 hours weekly	Oversee small group of children weekly. Plan lesson, execute lesson, participate in opening and build relationships with children. Ages Pre-school - 8 th grade. Attend leaders meetings.

Position	Time Commitment	Description
Lyfe Small Group Leader	2-3 hours weekly	Oversee small group of 6th, 7th or 8th grade students on Wednesday nights. Plan small group time. Build relationships. Participate in retreats, lock-ins and mission projects.
Children's Christmas Program Leaders	4+ hours week Oct-Dec 12th	Oversee your specific area of the program (music, parts, props, staging, set-up, or clean-up)
Children's Ministry Audio/Visual	1-2 hours weekly	Point person for A/V in Adventure Outpost. Be trained on how to run sound board, projector, and computer. Be able to teach students how to use equipment.
Children's Sunday School Assistant	1-1.5 hours weekly	Assist Leader. Ages 3 - 6 th grade. Encourage students to participate in lesson. Attend leaders meeting.
VBS Superintendents	1 yr commitment 0-1 hrs per week 6 mo before VBS 4+ hrs per week 1 month before VBS	Oversee specific area of VBS and their volunteers. Serve on the VBS Leadership team.
VBS Leaders and Assistants	5 hrs the month before VBS 3 hrs per day during VBS	Oversee your specific area of VBS (pre-school crafts, story time or music).
Sr. High Event Drivers/Leaders	Varies	Build relationships with students as you have opportunity as you drive to or lead youth events.
Sr. High Food/Event Helpers	Varies	Prepare, serve, and clean up food and drinks for youth ministry. No preparation time. Just a willingness to hang out with high school students on occasion.
Sr. High Leaders on Trips	Varies	Help to plan, organize, lead various parts of the particular trip you are attending. Lead small group discussions and serve as a shepherd to a small group of students.

Position	Time Commitment	Description
Sr. High Fundraisers Leaders/Helpers	Varies	Help to plan, organize, staff, etc. one of the fundraisers determined by the parents and students involved in high school ministry.
Sr. High Small Group Leader	5-8 hours monthly	Build relationships with high school students through bi-weekly small group sessions as you serve as their primary shepherd.
Women's Ministry Team	2 hours 1-2 x month	This team is committed to connecting women together through a variety of means so that we can be encouraged, challenged, and strengthened in our desire to grow as women who love the Lord.
Women's Retreat	20-30 hours yearly	An annual retreat is planned by this team. The retreat provides women an opportunity to build relationships, study God's word and relax.
MOPS Team	7-12 hours monthly	Serve the Lord by bringing Jesus to our Community through the mothers of small children. This team plans the bi-weekly event for the year. MOPS is a Christian-based program designed to strengthen and encourage women with children ages newborn to preschool by celebrating motherhood, meeting needs, making connections, and experiencing God's love.
MOPS Mentors	9-11:15am 2 x month	Attend meetings and social events. Greet moms and facilitate meetings. Offer guidance and encouragement to new moms. Be a sounding board. Assist with infants during meetings and in the nursery when needed.
MOPS Caregivers	9-11:15am 2 x month	Watch children during meetings in the nursery. Teach curriculum to 2-4 year olds that has been prepared for you.
Hospital and Home-bound Visitation	Varies, as needed	Assist the Pastor in providing friendship, encouragement and prayer to those who are hospitalized, in assisted living situations or homebound.

Position	Time Commitment	Description
Donuts with Dad Event Assistance	Set up 1 hour 1 x in January	Assistance is needed in the set up tables and chairs. Set up would take place on Monday.
Teacher Resource/ Supply Room	As needed	This volunteer would put supplies back in their designated spots, clean our and organize supply areas and teachers lounge.
Teacher Appreciation Snack/Lunch/ Breakfast	As needed Periodically throughout the year	Show our teachers how much we appreciate them with a treat or a meal.
Library Assistant	As needed throughout the year	Shelve and organize books in the preschool library
Scholastic Book Fair	8:30-10:00am, 11:15-12:00pm, 2:15-3:15pm 3-4pm Friday pack up	Cashiers are needed for each day of this week. They will be trained to work an automated cash register, involving receipt of cash, check, or charge, give change, and sack books and items purchased. Remaining books will be packed up on Friday.
Muffins with Mom Event Assistance	Set up 1 hour 1x in May	Set up of tables and chairs. Set up would take place on a Monday.
Produce Graduation Video	3 hours 1x in May	Put together a video of pictures set to music.
Graduation Event Assistance	6:45-8:30pm 2 x in May	An assistant in the sound booth is needed for this event. Requirements would be operating knowledge of the CD and DVD players. The lighting in the Life Center, monitoring the microphones, and running a video would be part of the evening.

Position	Time Commitment	Description
Greater Things Leadership Team	3-4 hours seasonal (March - August)	Helps to choose local projects, identifies Project Managers, and assists in all aspects of planning and implementing the Greater Things Event.
Greater Things Project Coordinator	5 hours	Is the key liaison between Lord of Life and the work site. Serves as the primary contact with those working on their team.
LOL Haiti Classic	20 hours Seasonal (January - June)	Be a part of this fun team by joining us as we plan and execute various aspects of this annual fundraiser for Haiti missions. The event consists of a Golf Tournament, Auction and a Wine & Cheese Party. If you are passionate about missions, this team is for you!
CSM Volunteer	Time given is determined by the individual	Volunteers are the key resource needed to carry out the projects identified by the CSM Team. Volunteers may serve a meal at a soup kitchen, distribute groceries to the poor and homeless, help rebuild in an area devastated by a natural disaster, etc.
First Serve Team Leader	Time given is determined by individuals	The good news is that people want to serve! Even better news is that there is a multitude of service opportunities right here near home. We are looking for people who will utilize their organizational gifts to lead a "one and done" local service project or a project that happens on a more regular basis.
Our Redeemer Soup Kitchen	4 hours	Our Redeemer Lutheran Church in downtown KC serves a hot meal to the people in their neighborhood who are hungry. They also lead them in worship prior to the meal. Giant Sale Team	Whatever hours you can give will be helpful. Every hour given is a blessing	Sorting; pricing; moving furniture & tables; kitchen cleaning; greeting; assisting with signs; childcare; greeting; donating refreshments; cashiering; and many more tasks
Haiti Missions Team	1 week of service overseas as well as 10-15 hours of pre-trip planning	The Haiti Missions Team is made up of people who desire to participate in a short-term mission experience with our sister congregation in Merotte, Haiti. We run medical clinics, sports camps, children's events, and in general work to build relationships with the people of Haiti.
MLM Food Give Away	4 hours 2nd Saturday morning of every month	MLM, one of our ministry partners sponsors a food giveaway program where several hundred families are served. People line up for blocks to receive various grocery items. Workers are needed to distribute items, help people shop, and to carry groceries to cars or nearby homes. MLM Breakfast Ministry	4 hours Saturday mornings	Every Saturday morning, MLM sponsors a hot breakfast to feed the homeless and poor of downtown KC.
